The Evolve Salon requires long hair to be tied back, jewellery to be removed for hygiene purposes, and suitable clothing and shoes worn, with shoulders and torso covered.

Hairdressing & Barbering

Get a glimpse into this exciting, fast-paced and varied industry in this practical, hands-on session where you will get to try out a range of hairstyling techniques. Find out how stylists keep on top of trends including balayage and special occasion styles and the products used in our Evolve Eco Salon. Please tie back long hair, remove jewellery for hygiene purposes, and ensure you are wearing suitable clothing and shoes, with torso and shoulders covered, and closed in shoes.

Make-Up Artistry

This industry is big business, so find out where careers in Make-Up Artistry can take you, whether that's into special effect make-up for theatre and TV, or occasion make-up. You will also have the chance to practice a number of make-up application techniques.

HUMANITIES

Classic Civilisation

This subject provides an enthralling combination of literature and ancient history. You will follow the adventures of the hero, Odysseus as he makes his perilous way home after the Trojan war encountering malevolent monsters and vengeful gods along the way. We explore the reign of Rome's first emperor, Augustus and the political spin he employed to ensure he remained in power after a turbulent period of civil war.

History

Find out if history really does repeat itself in this insightful taster session. We will also debate and challenge some of the thoughts and opinions of some key events that have helped shaped the last 150 years.

Law

Intrigued by how the legal system works? Discuss some of the tough issues that law has to deal with every day. Court will also be a focus in this session, where you will have a go at being the judge and attempt to use legal rules to arrive at fair judgements for defendants, victims, and wider society.

Politics

Come along to this lively Politics taster session where we provide a different insight into the world we live in, both past and present. We want to hear your opinions on the political agendas and how you think the country should be run. You'll also find out where A-Level Politics can take you next.

IT & COMPUTING

Computer Science

Learn some simple programming skills to create a range of animations in this entirely practical taster session. You don't need to be a computer whiz, all you need are basic mouse and keyboard skills and a good imagination!

Esports

Developed with the British Esports Association, this cutting-edge course will give you the skills, knowledge and qualifications needed to successfully make it in the Esports and creative industries. As well as developing your skills, you'll explore the culture of Esports, events management, technical production and a variety of game genres.

Games Design & Development

It doesn't matter what instrument you play, we will get you working alongside current students arranging and performing your own version of current popular songs. Students are asked to bring their instruments with them to this session, so that we can rehearse and perform well-known music tracks as a group. By the end of the session, you will have come up with a whole arrangement of the sort of music we study here at college in all of our courses, and we might record and post our performances too. We have some guitars, basses and drum kits, and amps and leads available.

PUBLIC UNIFORMED SERVICES

Uniformed Protective Services

Find out what it takes to start a career in the Armed Forces, Police, Fire Service, Border Force, or the Prison Service. Get involved with a number of practical activities, learn more about the classroom-based theory and exciting outside team activities that go on during the course such as kayaking and trips abroad. Please wear or bring clothes suitable for outdoor activities, e.g. tracksuit bottoms and trainers.

SCIENCE

Biology

This is your chance to explore how living organisms function, as you conduct a fascinating experiment investigating the effects of alcohol on the heart rate of a water flea. See their structure under a microscope and witness the effects live before your eyes.

Chemistry

Explore organic chemistry in this fascinating taster session. You will look at a range of carbon compounds including petroleum fuels, food, medicines, cosmetics, clothes, DNA and life! You will explore how organic molecules can flavour food, create perfumes and make your own mirror through a range of hands-on experiments.

Criminology and Forensic & Criminal Investigation

If your TV's always on the 'True Crime' channel, then you'll love this session looking into why people commit crimes. Should there be more lenient or harsher sentencing for certain crimes? And what role does the media play in influencing the way we view crimes? See why laws change over time and find out which subjects perfectly complement this course.

Geography & Geology

Come and get involved with our Geography & Geology taster session and find out why there has never been a better or more important time to study these fantastic subjects. With growing interest in issues such as climate change, migration, environmental degradation and globalisation, they are some of the most relevant courses you could choose to study.

Philosophy

Exercise your intellectual and imaginative abilities in this taster session. Focus on the benefits of thinking and questioning without expecting definite answers. Learn to build and evaluate arguments and explore a range of key concepts in philosophy. These include, 'how do we gain knowledge?', 'what is a mind?', and 'how do we make ethical decisions?'

Physics

Physics is a fascinating subject that will help you develop a range of practical, analytical and evaluative skills. In the first year, you will learn about mechanics, electric circuits, and materials. In the second year, we will cover more advanced topics such as nuclear and particle physics, thermodynamics, space, and gravitational fields.

Psychology

Learn more about the amazing organ that is our brain in this taster session. Take part in activities that will help you understand the anatomy of the brain while discussing examples of what happens when the brain is damaged. We will also explore our memory, looking at how we can test its reliability and ways to improve it so we can remember more information!

Sociology

Join us for our Sociology taster session where you will start to develop a critical view of the world we live in. Question, discuss and evaluate a range of social issues and understand society, including its complex relationships between human beings. We'll discuss sexism, racism, crime, religion, education, and equality.

Take a look at how our bodies respond to exercise, the skills important for becoming a coach, and how our mindset can affect performance and progress. Throughout the session, we'll tell you about the different career routes within the sport and fitness industry and receive information on our sports academies.
