# A-LEVELS

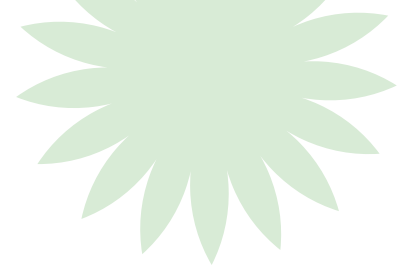
<b>Art History</b>	Have you ever wondered about art and the lives of artists? In this session you will be looking at different art objects, learning how they were created and why they are so important. Looking at art in the historical and contemporary context gives you a crucial knowledge of world civilisations. The visual and analytical skills that can be applied in many walks of life and the tools to understand how images and objects work to shape our social and political identities.
<b>Biology</b>	Why are sales of energy drinks banned for under 16s? What is the science behind this decision? How do we know this? During this Biology taster you will undertake an A-level Biology practical and learn how deeper biological understanding can impact our lives.
<b>Business</b>	The power of branding: In this taster session we will be focusing on the symbolic meaning of brands and how they permeate society in the 21st century. In addition we will apply marketing theory to a range of familiar brands.
<b>Chemistry</b>	Chill out with an interactive Chemistry session all about reactions that take in heat and energy. You will also be able to design your own product based on the reactions you perform.
<b>Classical Civilisation</b>	This subject provides an enthralling combination of literature and ancient history. You will follow the adventures of the hero, Odysseus as he makes his perilous way home after the Trojan war encountering malevolent monsters and vengeful gods along the way. We explore the reign of Rome's first emperor, Augustus and the political spin he employed to ensure he remained in power after a turbulent period of civil war.
<b>Criminology</b>	You will be encouraged to begin to think like criminologists, to question some of the misconceptions you might have about criminal and deviant behaviour and to discuss your views about certain offences and the related sentences for those crimes. It also provides the opportunity to introduce the role of campaigns in bringing about changes to the law and the methods that can be used in these campaigns.
<b>Drama</b>	This is a fun, practical taster session for students currently taking GCSE Drama or BTEC Performing Arts who want to explore continuing their studies at college.
<b>Economics</b>	Have you ever been curious about the circular flow of money and how governments make economic decisions? Have you ever wondered how the economy will grow and how AD will increase consumption? Using classical economic theory we explore the relationship between economic growth and future economic policy.



<b>English Language</b>	Have you ever wondered about how the English language developed? Ever wondered where accents come from? Why do we have different perceptions of different accents? Come along and find out at our A-Level English Language session.
<b>English Literature</b>	Do you like to read? Do you write in your spare time? Join us for our A-Level English Literature taster session where you'll explore different genres and how writers use language to influence millions of people every day.
<b>Environmental Science</b>	Are you interested in finding out more about the impact of human activity on our planet? Perhaps you are interested in conservation and would like to know more about how we can help conserve some of the worlds best-loved creatures. If this sounds like you, then come and join with like minded people by choosing A-Level Environmental Science.
<b>Film Studies</b>	Are you a bit of a film buff? Have you ever wondered why the world is in love with Hollywood or what movies make for a great first date? Join us for an overview of some classic films, and learn to identify various camera shots and angles used to construct movies and tell the stories we love.
<b>Fine Art</b>	Have you ever described a work of art? In pairs you will analyse a piece and translate this information into your own sketch descriptions. Please note: this is only suitable for those taking GCSE Art.
<b>Geography</b>	Have you ever wanted to make sense of the world and understand how humans and the earth interact? This interactive session will scratch the surface of this fascinating subject.
<b>Graphic Design</b>	During this Graphics taster session, you will explore the expressive nature of letters and typography. Please note: this session is only suitable for those studying an Arts related GCSE.
<b>History</b>	We are not makers of history, we are made by history. Those who do not remember the past are condemned to repeat it. Are you interested in how history informs the world we live in today? Join us in our history taster session where you will look into the racial inequalities in America and discover where these stemmed from in America's complex and turbulent past.
<b>Law</b>	What's the worst thing you can do, and how bad will your punishment be? In the law taster, we will explore a range of "crimes", and discuss their relative seriousness and how an appropriate penalty is reached.



<b>Maths</b>	Enjoy puzzles and problem solving? During our taster session you'll take part in a typical hands on lesson on honing your algebraic skills and using them to problem solve. You'll also find out what's in the whole course and what's needed to succeed in it.
<b>Media Studies</b>	The media surrounds our lives like the air we breathe! This session will guide you across the media landscape that's studied on the course. Explore how adverts subtly persuade us; question whether Beyonce's music videos are just pop, or is there a sincere message? What does it mean to be a fan of 'Stranger Things' in 2025? It's all here.
<b>Medical Science</b>	From Lab to Life-Saving. Ever wondered what happens behind the hospital doors? This taster session gives you a hands-on look at clinical medicine and diagnostic science. Instead of just reading about biology, you'll act as a medical investigator
<b>Philosophy</b>	How do we know we're not just a brain in a vat? How do we know we're not living in a simulation like The Matrix? What's the difference between belief and knowledge? Focus on the benefits of thinking and questioning without expecting definite answers. Learn to build and evaluate arguments and explore a range of key concepts in philosophy.
<b>Photography</b>	During this Photography taster, we'll explore the use of found objects and imagery to create a new work of art in the photographic darkroom.
<b>Physics</b>	During our Physics taster you'll get involved with an interactive demonstration of how physics is used in real life. This is the perfect introduction to Physics!
<b>Politics</b>	Come along and discover how decisions are made at the ballot box. We will create your own manifestos, present them and hold an election, looking at the impact the voting system has on the results.
<b>Psychology</b>	Why do we behave the way we do? Psychology is the study of mind and behaviour and aims to answer this question. Explore psychological approaches to explaining your mind and the impact this has on your behaviour, along with scientific research methods used to explore human behaviour.
<b>Sociology</b>	During this sociology taster session you will be introduced to some of the key thinking ideas and concepts used in sociology, and to start to develop the range of skills that students will need to build on throughout the course.
<b>Spanish</b>	Experience an exciting taster session filled with conversation and games in Spanish. Please note: you must be studying GCSE Spanish or can speak Spanish to join this session.



Art & Design	
<b>Printmaking Hybrid Creatures (Double Session)</b>	Ever wondered how graphic design and printmaking processes are used in tandem to create viable artwork for sale or marketing? Learn how to get hands-on creatively with this monoprinting session to create one-off handmade images to take home.
<b>Photography - Photograms &amp; Cyanotype (Double Session)</b>	Have an interest in photography? During this session you will learn some hands-on techniques to create your own photograms and cyanotypes and explore the great concepts behind great image making in this experimental photography workshop.
<b>Worlds Smallest Sculpting (Double Session)</b>	During this creative taster session, you will have the opportunity to create your very own miniature sculpture that can fit directly into a matchbox.
<b>3D Monster Sculpting (Double Session)</b>	Do you enjoy designing and creating creatures and monsters? Ever wanted to bring them to life in 3D? Join this taster session for a crash course in 3D Sculpting and creature design within Cinema 4D. 3D Sculpting is used in almost every piece of media we see, from sculpting realistic animals for film to creating creatures of nightmares for TV this intro session will give you a taste of doing this yourself.
<b>Character Design: Digital Drawing &amp; Painting Characters (Double Session)</b>	Join us to get a feel for what it takes to develop and draw characters for game design. This taster session is perfect for those of you who aspire to become Animators, the techniques you will use are the same that are used in such shows as Arcane, Trigun, Baki and Attack on Titan.
<b>Ceramic Jack in the Green (Double Session)</b>	Are you a creative person with an interest in making things with your hands? Here we are offering a short bespoke clay workshop to make a 'Jack in the Green' wall hanging to take home.
<b>Textile Felting Curios (Double Session)</b>	Learn some textile techniques with this felt making taster session. You will create your very own curio or plushie and best of all you'll be allowed to take it home!
<b>Pattern Cut Your Own Beach Bag (Double Session)</b>	In this taster session, you'll create your own beach bag for the summer using pattern cutting and sewing techniques!

### Beauty Therapy

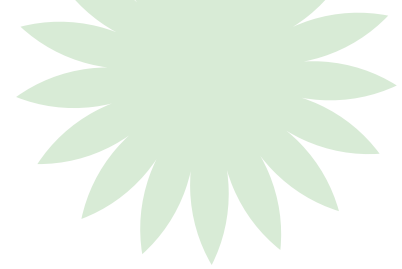
Do you aspire to a career in the diverse, exciting and ever evolving beauty industry? During this taster session you learn how to make a product and perform basic techniques such as exfoliation.
